# ICBC WIS: REGISTRATION & FEES

1. Please register your child/children
  - Highly recommend registering online thru ICBC website
  - Helps us maintain accurate database
  - Email list used by teachers to communicate class and school info
2. Please make payments by 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of the month
  - \$50/child/month (maximum of \$150/month/family)
  - \$35/child one-time per year activity fee (used for books, supplies during activity days)



# ICBC WIS: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Please drop off on time and pick up promptly
- Masjid construction in full swing
  - Please observe all posted signs
  - Drive very carefully inside ICBC parking lot
- Ensure your child is appropriately dressed
  - Highly preferable to have long pants for boys and scarves for girls
- Supplies needed each day: a pencil, spiral notebook, folder
  - Please ensure your child has these supplies
  - has already made wudu before coming to school
