### Introduction

#### Why are we discussing Shariah?

In the past year or so, one of the hottest topics in the America is Shariah. There are those who spend tremendous amount of resources to create the fear that Shariah is about to reign over USA causing:

- "destruction of the national existence of the United States";
- "destroying Western civilization from within..."
- Not only is the ignorance of the man in the street but politicians "an infiltration ... into all of our operating systems in our country as well as across Western civilization. So we must be willing to recognize that enemy."

### Introduction...

- one such presidential hopeful calls Shari'ah "a mortal threat to the survival of freedom in the United States and in the world as we know it."
- As a result of this false propaganda and made-up fear, the term Shari'ah has not only become a bad and ugly term but currently there are almost two-dozen states that have proposed legislation to prohibit the use of Shari'ah.

### Introduction...

#### What that would mean for us Muslims?

- we are caught talking about Shariah we can be jailed.
- Or if we make Wudhu (ablution) in a public place we can be fined or jailed.
- Even if we offer our daily Salah (prayer) openly we can be jailed.
  Basically anything to do with Shariah would be enough to get us in trouble.

## So, What is the Perception?

- American Muslims cannot be trusted
- Against women rights (women cannot drive in Saudi Arabia, Honor killing, etc)
- Islam does not belong in America (foreign religion)
- Muslim Organizations have a secret agenda
- Islam is against religious freedom

So, know the facts – be knowledgeable

# Challenges in Challenging the Perception

- Islamophobia
  - Hollywood has not adopted it yet. It has not become a bad word.
- Popular Opinion not in our favor
  - 37% have favorable opinion of Muslims
  - 58% of New Yorkers support NYPD surveillance of Muslims in New York
  - 39% support special ID card for Muslims

# Challenges.....

#### Discrimination on the rise (Zogby)

- In 2003, 38% of young Arab-Americans reported being discriminated.
- In 2004, 65% of young Arab-Americans said the same.
- In 2007, 76% of young Arabs said they were personally discriminated against.

## Shariahphobia

- Almost 25 States have considered some kind of anti-Shariah bill (passed in LA, AZ and TN)
- A 42 million dollar funded campaign to flame Shariahphobia
- Islamophobic organizations are actively pushing Shariaphobia agenda.
- Main media and Right Wing social media

### Definition of Shariah...Religious

- Shariah is the embodiment of ALL of the, guidance and directives that Allah (SWT) has prescribed for humanity in the Quran or given by Prophet Muhammad (SAS) through his sayings and actions (in order to perfect their lives) whether they pertain to matters of:
  - Belief
  - Deeds/Actions
  - Character

# Definition of Shariah: Connecting the meanings


Source of something as Allah (SWT):

- Path to a watering place: Shariah is that path that leads to source of energy and life.


# Definition of Shariah: Connecting the meanings

- Legislation: A good portion of the Shariah deals with legislation regulation and law


# Scope of Shariah
