#### ICBC 2020-2021 WIS: Policies & Guidelines

- Min cutoff age to enroll in Sunday school is 5 years as of Oct 30
  - > Cannot accept anyone younger than that
  - > Cutoff date for registering to Sunday school for the year is Oct 11
- ❖ We will enroll students for four Sundays after Sep 13 for the year
  - ➤ No enrollment after the cutoff date Oct 11. This is the last date to register for the year
  - > Students registering after this date will be put on the waitlist
  - ➤ Maximum students per class is 30
  - Registration in class is on first-come basis
- More than 4 Sundays absence will need to come back following year and will lose their seat
  - Exception: If said absence has a written excuse from ICBC WIS

#### ICBC 2020-2021 WIS: Policies & Guidelines

Ensure that children are **ON-ONLINE on-time** and remain in compliance with guidelines listed below.

- Please make sure that the children keep mics muted unless asked by the teacher
- ◆ All student must keep their camera on during the classes (unless no cameras for their laptop/desktop etc.)
- Children should come prepared to the meetings with the required materials
- Participate in learning activities attentively
- Report any unsafe situation to the school authorities
- ◆ Adhere to the defined dress code guidelines
- Respect for Others : being polite and kind to everyone and everything
- ◆ Fairness: treating everyone equally
- Concern for Others : caring for and helping others
- Ensure that the children have a notebook and pencils handy

**Important note to Parents:** For Ages 5-10, we need your help to ensure the class can be run effectively

#### Excerpt from the ICBC Children's policy

- 1. Children under the age 13 shall not be left unattended within ICBC premises
- 2. Children must have the contact information of their parents / guardians with them at all times (Full name, Address, and Phone Number)
- 3. Children should be present with their parent during prayers. Parents are advised to keep their children next to them or in the prayer area and they should remain respectful during prayer.
- 4. Parents/Guardian should pick up their child immediately after any activities have been completed
- 5. Food shall not be consumed inside the Masjid during prayers or Jumu'ah khutbah
- 6. Property damage to the facility and / or equipment will result in parents / guardian being liable to cost or repair/ replacement
- 7. ICBC nor its governing body can be held responsible for any injuries or harm that may happen to any child or adult due to their neglect or lack of supervision.
- 8. Parents bear the full responsibility for the actions of their children.
