



GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN AT ICBC

Assalamu alaikum wa rahmatullahi wa barakaatuh!

These guidelines relate to children at the Islamic Center of Brushy Creek (ICBC) premises. For the safety and security of our children it is important that all community members and visitors comply with this policy.

It is the desire of ICBC to provide a safe and friendly environment for the entire community, and to avoid safety hazards that could take place and to preserve the sanctity of the Masjid.

- 1. Children under the age of 13 shall not be left unattended within ICBC premises.
- 2. Children must have the contact information of their parents /guardians with them at all times (Full name, Address, and Phone Number).
- 3. Children should be present with their parent during prayers. Parents are advised to keep their children next to them or in the prayer area and they should remain respectful during prayer.
- 4. Parents/Guardian should pick up their child immediately after any activities have been completed.
- 5. Food is not allowed inside the Masjid at any time.
- 6. Property damage to the facility and/or equipment will result in parents/guardian being liable to cost or repair/ replacement
- 7. ICBC nor its governing body can be held responsible for any injuries or harm that may happen to any child or adult due to their neglect or lack of supervision.
- 8. Parents bear the full responsibility for the actions of their children.

Failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in a formal warning. After two formal warnings, a third offense will be followed by notification to Child Protective Services and/or revoking access to activities.
